



Dakota Dolls Contract and Warranty

Contract of Sale for Kitten(s): _____

Dakota Dolls Ragdoll Cattery guarantees the health of the kitten at the time of transfer of ownership. The Breeder will not assume responsibility for any medical expenses incurred on the kitten. Should the kitten become ill the Buyer must notify the Breeder. Medical treatment or return of the kitten will be determined to remedy the condition. Be aware, a new kitten may show signs of stress including sneezing, runny nose, watery eyes, loose stool, constipation, etc... when brought into a new environment.

INIT: _____

The buyer must have the kitten examined by a licensed veterinarian within 5 business days of leaving our care or warranty shall be voided. Code provided to its new owner but provides 30 days of free pet insurance without waiting period for every kitten through Trupanion (the Buyer must respond to this offer directly with Trupanion within hours +/- of pick-up using code. The Buyer assumes responsibility for all medical expenses/deductible for the kitten/cat at the time the contract is signed (or before if the kitten is to be delivered). The Buyer will keep all vaccinations current and provide proper housing, husbandry, nutrition, and parasite prevention (deworming and flea/tick/heartworm prevention: to keep the kitten in healthy condition throughout its life (proof of such will be required with any warranty claim).

INIT: _____

Should the kitten become ill, the Breeder shall be notified (via email) within 48 hours and take proper steps to have the kitten seen and treated by the Buyer's veterinarian and, if necessary, a specialist. Of critical importance: kittens are very fragile and can rapidly regress, **kitten illness is an urgent care situation**, depression, lethargic, abnormal behavior, not eating/drinking, and vomiting/diarrhea are all examples of issues requiring urgent medical attention. This is of such importance, if the Buyer does not respond to kitten illness by urgently seeking veterinary care (seen within 24 hours from reported symptoms and appropriate follow up visits, the warrantee portion of this contract will be voided.

Should the Buyer not be able to keep the cat/kitten, the Buyer will provide the **right of first refusal** to the Breeder.

INIT: _____

Our warranty is voided if the kitten is given any of the **FeLV vaccine series, allowed to roam outside, declawed or bred.**

INIT: _____

Warranty

If your kitten or cat is diagnosed with a serious and life-threatening genetic (heritable) defect or congenital (developmental) condition. Within the first **3 years from date of birth** and is confirmed by a veterinary specialist of the condition, scientifically accurate methods, and necropsy (should the kitten pass) we will provide a replacement kitten of equal or lesser value. (all medical, transport and diagnostic costs are the responsibility of the Buyer).

INIT: _____

FIP (Feline Infectious Peritonitis) is a risk for every purebred cat. As FIP is neither genetic nor congenital, it is not covered by this warranty. If a kitten is diagnosed with FIP within **1 year from date of birth**, a replacement of equal or lesser value will be provided with documented evidence of illness for qualified licensed clinic or veterinarian.

INIT: _____

I understand that failure to meet the requirements will void all portions of the warrantee and is grounds for legal action. This warranty is offered only to the original Buyer. The Breeder's limit of liability is \$1000, the adoption cost of the kitten (not including spay/neuter). The Buyer will pay all court costs associated with any legal proceedings which will be required to occur in Steele County, North Dakota and under North Dakota law.
